NOTE: I have stated in previous training sessions the the learning process is a 4 steps. The first is to "Tell You" the intended information (Monday Night Phone Bridge M9T Training Net), second is to "Demonstrate or Show Examples of how it is used, Practical Presentation (Wed Night M9T Training Net), the third is "You Do it", the fourth is the "Evaluation" that determines if you go it and if not go through it once again. It is important to note that all of these steps are equally important and in sequence if one is to understand the subject matter.

It is also important to mention most of us learn in two ways, by presenting the material from the reference documentation or you reading the material or by visually seeing it in the form of an image or demonstration. The above process covers these two learning processes.

I look forward to your participation because as a team we can become proficient, well trained, operators. As I said when we were doing message, formatting, sending, and receiving:

Do not be afraid or uncomfortable if at first you are unclear of what you are doing or make mistakes because working through our mistakes is how we learn and become confident in doing what is expected of us.

Our goal for this year, as it was last year, is to become proficient in sending, receiving, and relaying, messages, to have more members with the education and confidence to step up and provide NCS leadership in Region 9, and reach 100% Participation Reporting.

All of you need to accomplish these goals if we are to provide Army MARS with operators who, when required in an actual emergency, will be able to provide the support to our customers they expect. Working toward mission excellence is why we are here and working to become. As said many times "Army MARS is not for everyone" so if this program is way beyond the scope of what you want from an organization, please evaluate what it is you do want. It will be necessary for all of us in the future to be well trained in the Procedures, and Tools required to accomplish our mission. Please be attentive to the Training and Practice sessions so all of you will be able to participate at a high level of proficiency should we be called upon in an actual emergency.

I will ask all of you to mute you phone after checking in, If you have a question you will need to un-mute your line to be heard (*6 to mute and un-mute your line). When your question has been addressed, please make sure your line is muted again. I suggest you join the online meeting at least 5 minutes early to address any connectivity issues.
