WHAT IS THE RJMOG?

1. The RJMOG is a Joint Operations Staff tasked to execute a specific mission.
2. The most common mission is our quarterly exercises.

RJMOG RESPONSIBILITIES.

1. Ensure the Region network is staffed and scheduled. The Staff includes:
 - **Net Control station(s)**. Runs the net, takes check-ins, directs traffic, etc.
 - **Duty Officer**. Has overall responsibility for everything that happens on the net. Checking traffic Coming into and going out of the region. Replying to any tasking not for all members.
 - **Minor Relay Station**. This station can have ALE or station manager and ms-dmt. This station moves Traffic From the Region to the higher nets and brings traffic back to the Region.
 - **Alternate Net Control**. This station assist the NCS with all aspects of the net.
 - **Reports Officer(s)** as needed. This station receives reports from other stations and consolidates Them into an ACP-127 message addressed to the station from the tasking message.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO THE RJMOG.

1. ALE Stations 24/7. There is one in CA,AZ,NV. The ALE stations will have all the incoming messages stored so members can retrieve them any time not just during a net.
 - CA ALE=XCA
 - AZ ALE=XAZ
 - NV ALE=XNV
2. There will be additional stations with Message Machine running on a fixed channel. These stations will Also store all incoming messages and members can retrieve them any time. These stations will be announced at the start of the exercise.

EXACUITION:

1. When a COMEX or Real World Emergency starts the members of the RJMOG will open a net on one of the 2 Region Primary Channels M023 or M068. Members should pick the channel that is best for that time of day and check in when a call is made for stations.
2. All stations checking into the net must make sure the following are all working.
3. Radio for both Voice and Digital. Test before the exercise.
4. Station Manager and MS-DMT. Test before the exercise.
5. Message Manager to create messages.
